General Instructions

Before assembling model, study sketch carefully. Avoid getting cement on outer surfaces of model sections. Use cement very sparingly and important—Apply cement to inside surfaces only. Avoid getting cement on hands, so as not to mar or smear plastic surfaces. Do not hurry. Work carefully and patiently. Important Note: Before proceeding to cement parts together, it is advisable to fit parts together dry (without cement) so that you may familiarize yourself with the parts and how they go together, also noting the points where cement is to be applied. For best results assemble model exactly in the order indicated.

ABOUT DRACULA

To this day Dracula has become a symbol associated with the Vampire. The chilling account of Dracula was first published in 1897, a horror romance type novel by Bram Stoker who lived from 1847-1912. With Gothic references of gloomy castles and open graves at midnight its realism and horror captured the reader. Stage plays and movies have been based on the world-wide king of the vampires, with his black formal attire and large cape suggesting his ability to change from human form to a vampire bat at will.

Horrible and sinister tales were handed down over the centuries telling of how the vampires came in the dark of night to claim their victims and turn them into vampires too. During the nineteenth century a blood chilling legend of Count Dracula unfolded in the form of journals and letters. He lived in Castle Dracula, as the legend goes, in the province of Transylvania in Rumania. The

castle was surrounded at night by wolves, preventing any person from leaving or entering. Living for centuries on the blood of human victims, the dreaded creature roamed only at night and returned to a coffin by day. The only known method to release the agonized soul of the vampire was to drive a stake through its heart as it lay immobile in its coffin.

The mere mention of Dracula's name caused frightened local residents to scurry to their homes, lock their doors and windows and place a crucifix at any possible avenue of entrance, sleeping with a crucifix or wreath of garlic around their necks to ward off the evil vampire.

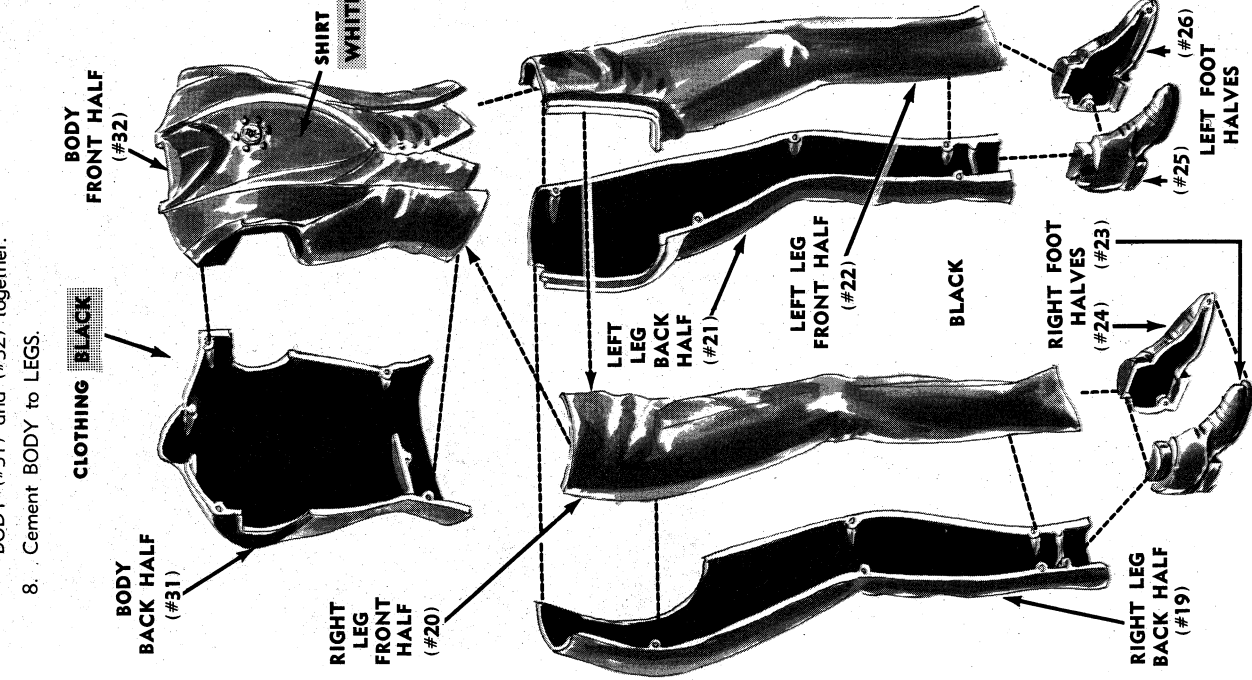
The legends of the vampire were best known in the Rumanian sector of the old world and many peasants living there today are still bound by the superstitious fear of the fictional vampire.

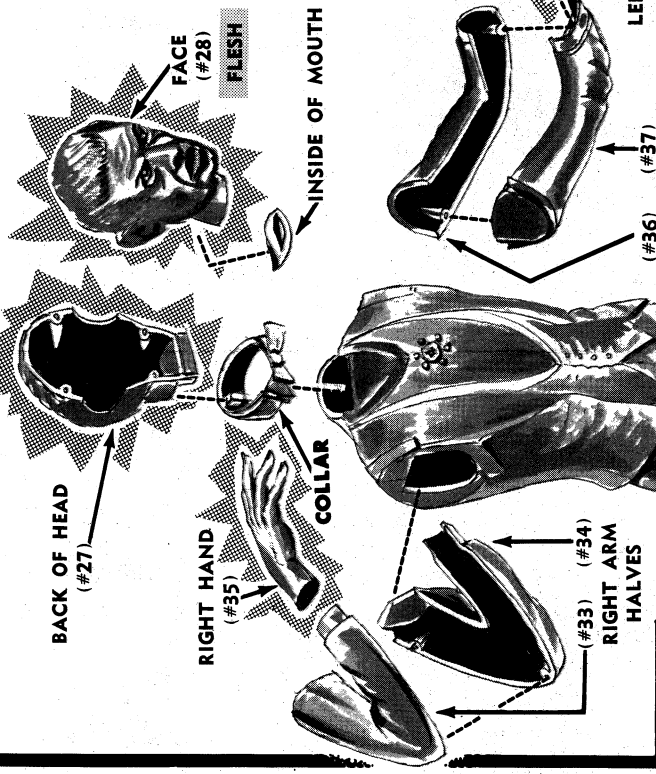
THIS MONSTER KIT INCLUDES PARTS MOLDED IN "FRIGHTENING" LIGHT-REFLECTING PLASTIC. BEFORE ASSEMBLING, TAKE ALL PARTS INTO A DARKENED ROOM OR CLOSED TO DE-TERMINE WHICH FEATURES TO PAINT AND WHICH TO LEAVE WITH GHOUL-ISH GLOW POWER.

1. Cement FRONT and BACK HALVES (#21) and (#22) of LEFT LEG together.
2. Cement FRONT and BACK HALVES (#19) and (#20) of RIGHT LEG together.
3. Cement LEFT FOOT HALVES (#25) and (#26) together.
4. Repeat for RIGHT FOOT (#23) and (#24).
5. Cement LEFT and RIGHT FEET to LEFT and RIGHT LEGS.
6. Cement LEFT and RIGHT LEGS together.
7. Cement FRONT and BACK HALVES of BODY (#31) and (#32) together.
8. Cement BODY to LEGS.

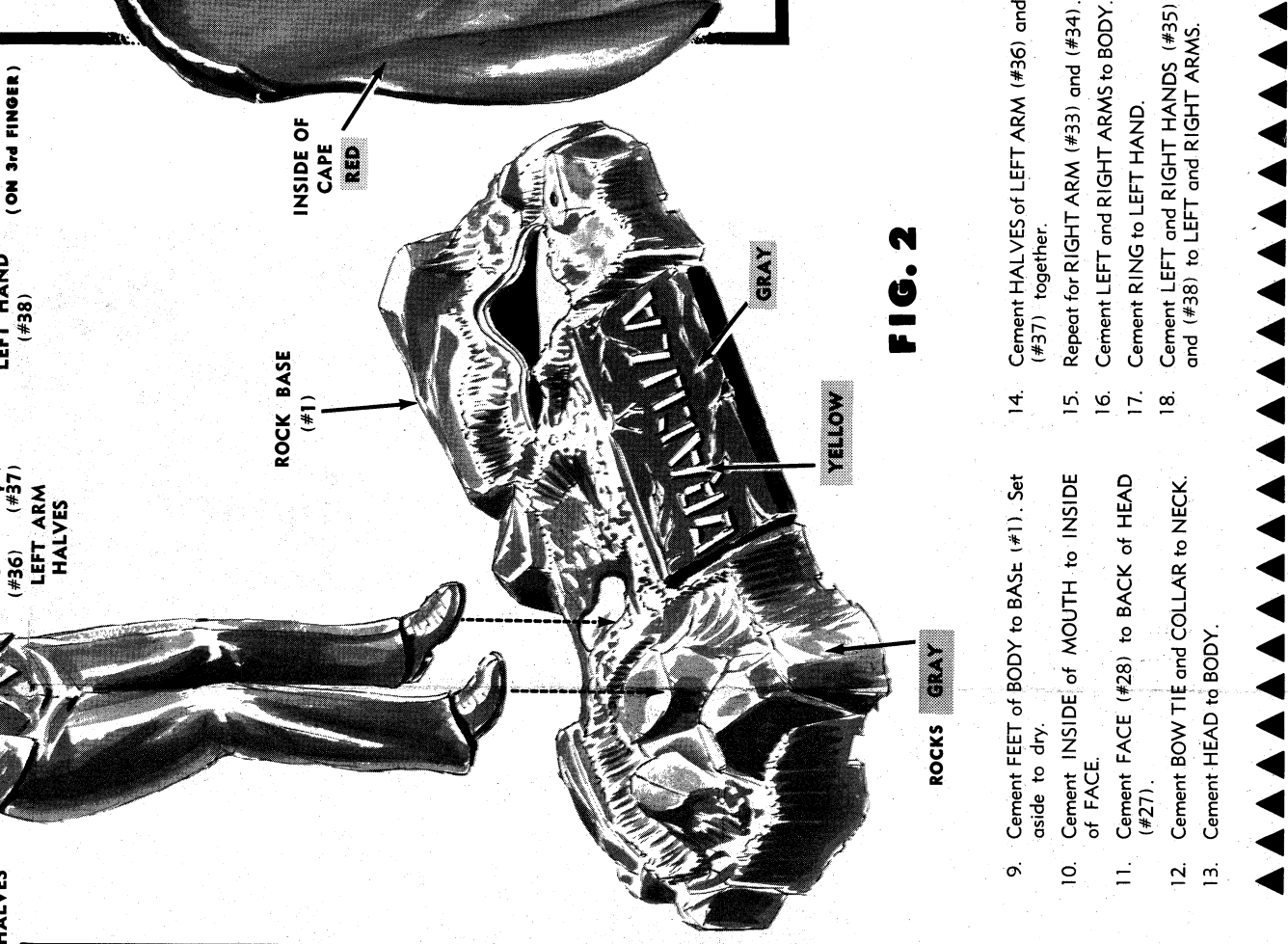


MODEL SCALE 1/8 ACTUAL SIZE



9. Cement FEET of BODY to BASE (#1). Set aside to dry.
10. Cement INSIDE of MOUTH to INSIDE of FACE.
11. Cement FACE (#28) to BACK of HEAD (#27).
12. Cement BOW TIE and COLLAR to NECK.
13. Cement HEAD to BODY.
14. Cement HALVES of LEFT ARM (#36) and (#37) together.
15. Repeat for RIGHT ARM (#33) and (#34).
16. Cement LEFT and RIGHT ARMS to BODY.
17. Cement RING to LEFT HAND.
18. Cement LEFT and RIGHT HANDS (#35) and (#38) to LEFT and RIGHT ARMS.

19. Cement BACK of CAPE to BODY.
20. Cement LEFT and RIGHT FRONT SECTIONS of CAPE (#41) and (#42) to BODY. Set aside to dry.
21. Cement HALVES of TREE TRUNK (#13) and (#14) together.
22. Cement TREE TRUNK to BASE.
23. Cement VARIOUS WEED PATCHES to BASE as indicated in sketch.
24. Cement BRANCHES to TREE TRUNK.
25. Cement (2) BATS to TREE BRANCHES.
26. Cement SPIDER to BASE.
