General Instructions

Before assembling model, study sketch carefully. Avoid getting cement on outer surfaces of model sections. Use cement very sparingly and important—Apply cement to inside surfaces only. Do not mar or smear plastic surfaces. Avoid getting cement on hands, so as not to mar or smear plastic surfaces. Do not hurry. Work carefully and patiently. Important Note: Before proceeding to cement parts together, it is advisable to fit parts together dry (without cement) so that you may familiarize yourself with the parts and how they go together, also noting the points where cement is to be applied. For best results assemble model exactly in the order indicated.

GODZILLA

Many years ago Japan was terrorized by a hideous monster called Godzilla. It destroyed villages and murdered countless numbers of people. No one knew where it came from but they surmised that Godzilla was a creature of prehistoric origin. As suddenly as it had come, the monster returned to the sea and disappeared, leaving a wake of death and destruction behind it. Time passed and Godzilla became only a half remembered legend.

In laboratories around the world seismographs recorded a disturbance in the polar regions. Japanese scientists took a submarine to the area of the disturbance. Radio contact on the mainland reported that the scientists found high radioactivity. A tremendous explosion was recorded on the seismographs. The submarine was never heard from again. 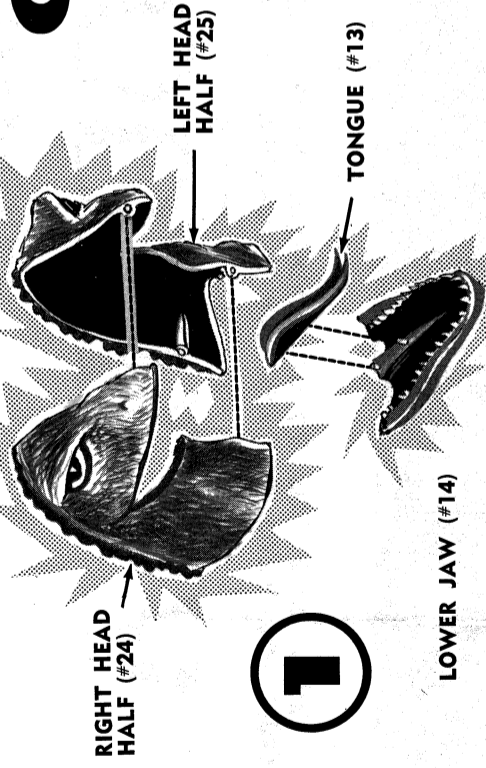

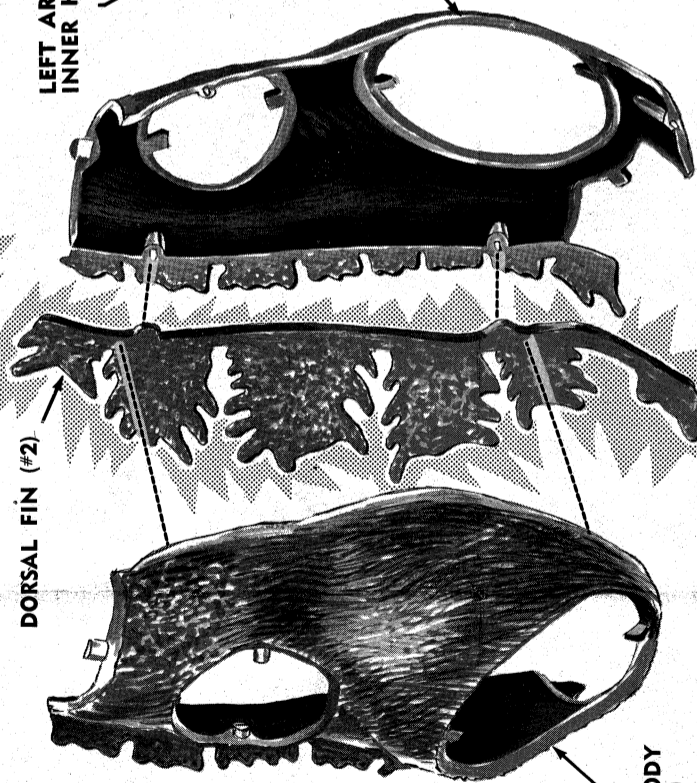

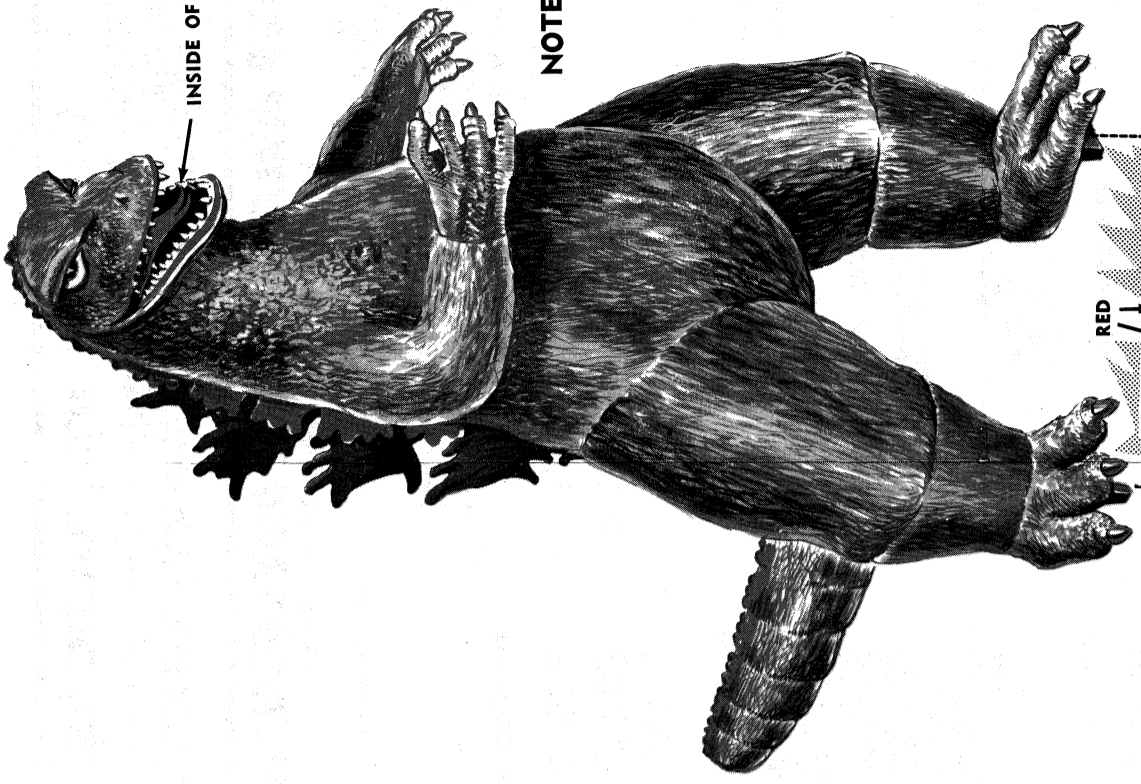
- Cement TONGUE (#13) to inside of LOWER JAW (#14).
- Cement LEFT (#25) and RIGHT (#24) HEAD HALVES together.
- Cement LOWER JAW to HEAD ASSEMBLY. Set aside to dry.
- Cement DORSAL FIN (#2) to LEFT BODY HALF (#1).
- Cement LEFT BODY HALF to RIGHT BODY HALF (#4). Set aside to dry.



FOR SUGGESTED DETAIL PAINTING SCHEME — SEE ILLUSTRATIONS. Paint parts as indicated and allow to dry before assembling.

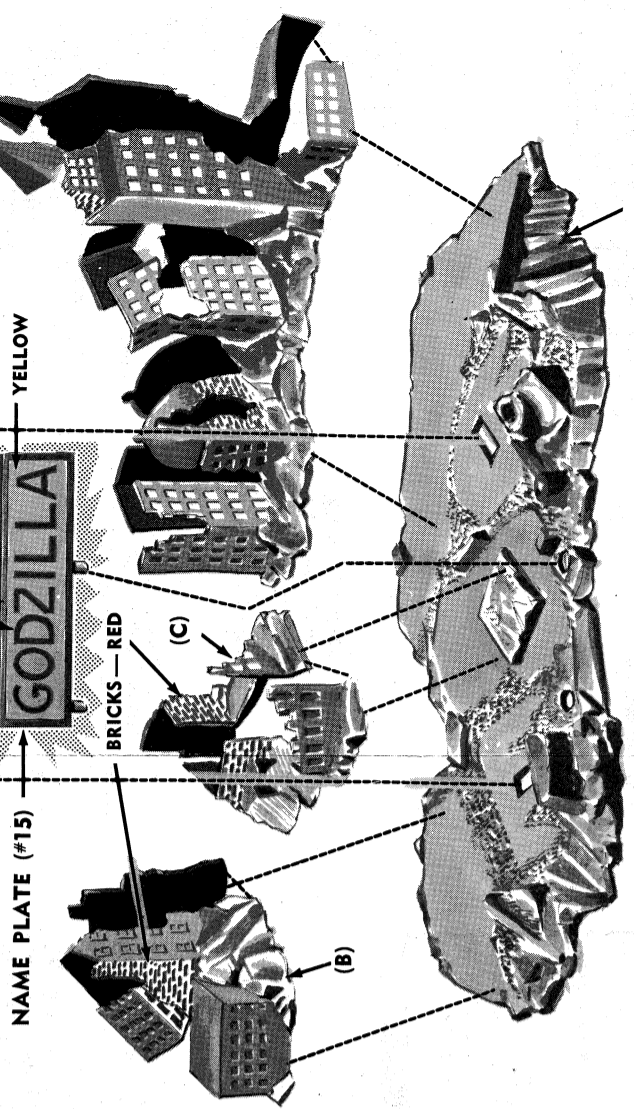
- Cement LEFT HAND INNER HALF (#10) to LEFT HAND OUTER HALF (#11).
- Cement LEFT ARM INNER HALF (#20) to LEFT ARM OUTER HALF (#6) together.
- Cement LEFT HAND to LEFT ARM. Set aside to dry.
- Cement RIGHT HAND INNER HALF (#9) to RIGHT HAND OUTER HALF (#12).
- Cement RIGHT ARM INNER HALF (#21) to RIGHT ARM OUTER HALF (#5) together.
- Cement RIGHT HAND to RIGHT ARM. Set aside to dry.

INSIDE OF MOUTH — RED

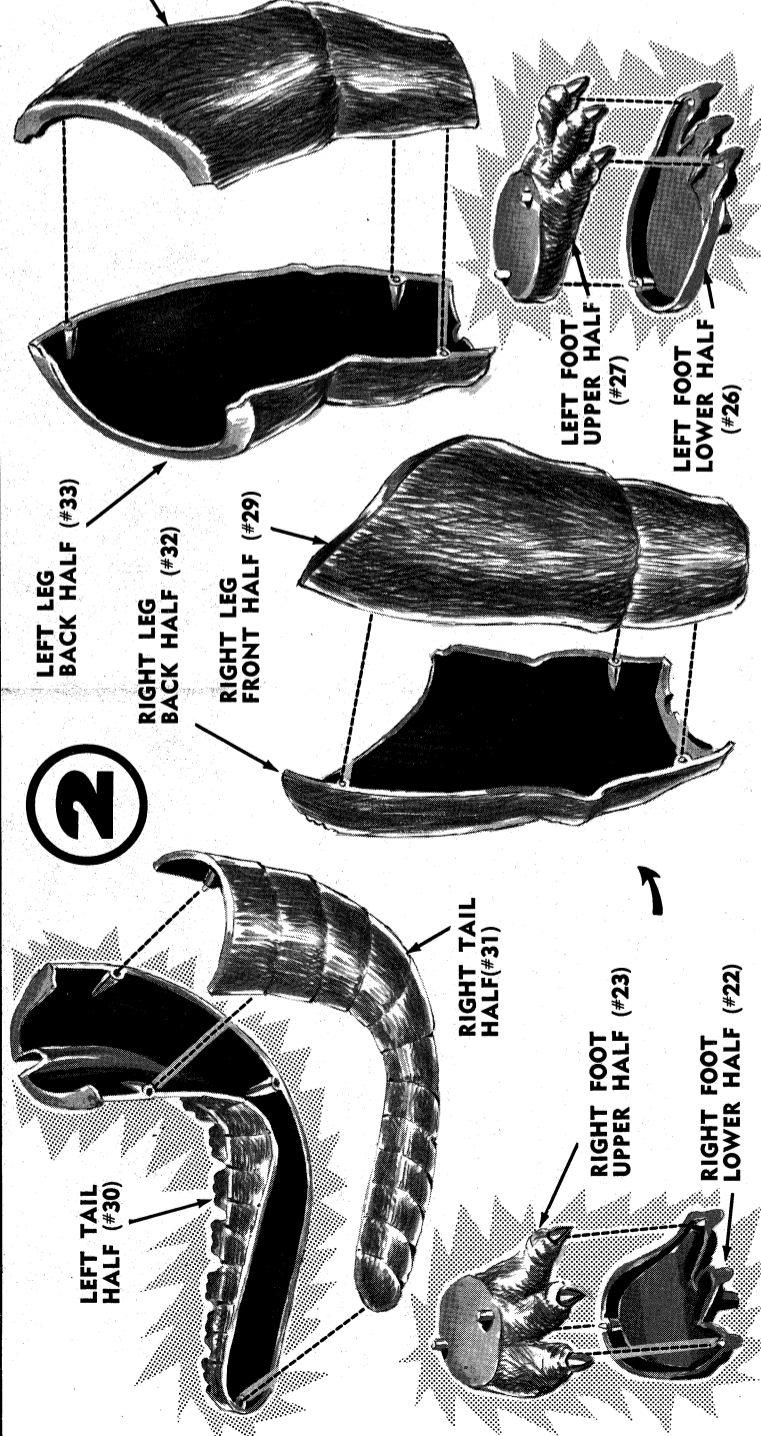

- Cement ASSEMBLED GODZILLA to BASE.
- Cement NAME PLATE (#15) to BASE.

- Cement LEFT TAIL HALF (#30) to RIGHT TAIL HALF (#31).
- Cement LEFT LEG BACK HALVES (#33) to LEFT LEG FRONT HALF (#28).
- Cement LEFT FOOT LOWER HALF (#26) to LEFT FOOT UPPER HALF (#27).
- Cement LEFT FOOT to LEFT LEG.
- Cement RIGHT LEG BACK HALF (#32) to RIGHT LEG FRONT HALF (#29).
- Cement RIGHT FOOT LOWER HALF (#22) to RIGHT FOOT UPPER HALF (#23).
- Cement RIGHT FOOT to RIGHT LEG.
- Cement HEAD to BODY, then ARMS to BODY.
- Cement TAIL and LEGS to BODY.
- Cement HALVES of RUINED BUILDING SECTIONS (A) (B) (C) together, then cement SECTIONS to BASE (#3).
